CLUBS

FEES



- No sign up fees
- Currently free for public clubs.
- Planned yearly fee between \$5-\$20 depending on country GDP, paid once regardless of the number of clubs you join.

- Full financial transparency required at all levels
- Direct electronic voting by members
- Does your current organization have the following in the Code of Conduct: *"Communications that contain criticism, complaints, accusations, allegations, etc., shall not be permitted and may be subject to disciplinary action."*?
